## ABOUT US

The primary objective of the PreK 2 class is to instill a genuine love of learning. We develop these skills through both active, creative and imaginary play. In the Two-Year old class, children are given the opportunity to develop important skills, such as, language development, awareness of others feelings and self control. Your child will be exposed to letters, numbers, shapes and colors through music, art, sensory play and other media. Each morning includes free play, structured small and large group work, fine and gross motor skills, stories, songs, craft, and snack. Our monthly lessons are planned to integrate our monthly topics and Bible themes. We strive to teach Biblical truths in an age appropriate manner.

## ABOUT US

In Pre-K 4, we embrace a whole-child approach to learning, integrating academic, physical, and social skills based on children's strengths and interests. We focus on foundational skills like attention span and confidence to support academic growth.

Our literacy and phonics curriculum is research-based, enhancing vocabulary and comprehension through various skills. We provide daily phonics instruction covering letter sounds and phonemic awareness activities.

Our guided math curriculum aligns with state standards, emphasizing math vocabulary, movement activities, class discussions, hands-on lessons, and number sense.

Fine motor skills are developed through play, providing meaningful practice for future handwriting success.

We celebrate diversity and creativity by introducing a monthly artist series that explores famous artists and different art styles. Most importantly, our teachings are rooted in Christian values, connecting lessons to Jesus in age-appropriate ways.

## ABOUT US

St. Philip's PreK 5 program is for younger 5 year olds and older 4's. Some families may want their child to have an extra year to grow emotional, socially and academically before kindergarten due to a late birthday or missing the kindergarten cut off. Whatever the reason, our PreK 5 class is designed for students to gain social and academic confidence as well as experiencing a more structured classroom environment. Our PreK 5 students participate in flexible morning group play, responsibility building classroom jobs, snack and story time, age appropriate carpet time and table time learning, small groups-individualized for abilities, themed centers; fostering independent exploration, and gross motor outdoor or indoor "Big Room" play scheduled into everyday. We also sprinkle movement breaks in between all of our learning activities.

We introduce the alphabet, highlighting a letter of the week, using the Writing Without Tears letter order instead of going from A-Z. We focus on letter sounds to form pre reading skills and implement hands on, stimulating, fun, fine motor strengthening activities to build writing skills.

We want learning to be fun, so we practice number sense, science, literacy, art, and music in an intentional, engaging way that makes our students excited to come to school everyday.

Teaching kids about Jesus is our passion at St. Philip's Preschool! We insert God into our day as much as we can with group discussion and prayer. We introduce a Bible story every month and teach scripture verses through memorization and movement. We want kids to know they are loved by Jesus!

## Teaching Philosophy

We use a non-denominational, Christian based curriculum to emphasize the teachings of Jesus and how they affect the children's daily lives.
